Guidelines for the Abstract

- Mention the Author's name with the full corresponding address, contact number (WhatsApp number), and e-mail.
- Papers can be submitted either in English/Bengali.
- Text- Times New Roman, font size 12 (double-spaced) and Avro, font size 14.
- Word limit should not exceed 300 words.
- · Keywords maximum 5.
- Participants are requested to submit the abstract by 1st June 2022 and the selected abstracts would be communicated by 3rd June 2022.

Guidelines for Full Paper

- Selected blind peer-reviewed papers/ book chapters on the aforementioned sub-themes will be published with ISBN by a reputed publisher.
- Interested research scholars and faculty members are invited to submit their original research paper.
- Papers can be submitted either in English/Bengali.
- Papers/articles which have been already published elsewhere and/or copyrighted or accepted for publication elsewhere will not be considered for publication.
- The Peer Review Committee reserves the right to edit or to request for re-submission of any material submitted without assigning any reason to the author(s).
- Word limits for abstract- 300, full paper- 3000-5000 and a brief Bio of the author/s (within 150 words).
- Author(s) should mention their full name and furnish their address and affiliation along with e-mail
 and contact phone number (preferably WhatsApp number). These details should be provided separately
 and the author's identity should not be disclosed either in the text or in the abstract. Sub-theme has to be
 mentioned below the title. In case of multiple authors, corresponding authors should be clearly mentioned.
- Papers should be typed in A4 size paper (double-spaced), in Times New Roman, font size 12 (English) or Avro, font size 14 (Bengali).
- The title should be typed in Times New Roman, font size 14, uppercase (English) and Avro, font size 16 (Bengali).
- Sections and subsections should be serially numbered. The introductory section should be as brief as
 possible.
- Tables and figures should be numbered using Arabic numerals.
- The list of References should be provided at the end of the paper to be arranged alphabetically.
- Reference should be based on the American Psychological Association (APA) format.
