Date - 30/05/16 - 05/06/16

By the initiatives of the NSS UN IT of NETAJI SARABARSHIKI MAHAVIDYALAY, ASHOKNAGAR, a SPECIAL CAMPING PROGRAMME was organised from 30/05/16 to 05/06/16 in the Puntia-Bhatchhala village area under the Banshpool Gram Panchayat.

The said programme was inaugurated on 30/05/16 in the office of the Banshpool Gram Panchayat by the Panchayat Pradhan, Md. Zinna Khayer Mondal. The written message well wish of the principal of our College was read out there.

During 30/05/16 & 31/05/16, for two days, a survey was conducted in Puntia-Bhatchhala village area. The NSS volunteers very skilfully finished this survey work. From this survey various aspects of social, economic and physical problems, like dearth of potable/drinking water, malnutrition of children, vitamin deficiency, anaemia of the household women folk, etc.—came out sharply.

On 01/06/16 a Health Camp was arranged at the home of the Panchayat Pradhan, Md. Zinna Khayer Mondal. Dr. Aparna Bhattacharya of Ashoknagar State General Hospital was graceful enough to attend the camp. Under her guidance a Medical Team visited more than one hundred patients of the area and treated them. This particular activity seemed to have given the villagers much benefit.

On 02/06/16 an awareness campaign was arranged among the villagers in the Bhatchhala for keeping the household and environment clean. Together with this bleaching powder was prayed on the unclean area of the village. Lime was sprayed in the ponds which the villagers used. Apart from this, the NSS Team visited the poultry firms of the village and made awareness campaign so that the poultry-waste did not pollute the environment.

On 03/06/16 & 04/06/16, a Free-coaching Camp was arranged for the village kids for these two days. There the kids were given lessons on Bengali, Mathematics, English & General Knowledge, etc., together with giving training of drawing pictures and reciting rhymes.

On 05/06/16 was the World Environment Day. On that day tree-saplings were implanted in the Puntia-Bhatchhala village to make the villagers aware of what environment was. On that very day a training programme was arranged for the village women on handicrafts. This training was given by the volunteers of the college NSS UNIT.


09/01/2017: An herbal garden was prepared through plantation of various herbal trees and herbs.

On 30.08.2017 about 44no of volunteers of Netaji Satabarshiki Mahavidyalay celebrate Briksharopan programme.








Day1 of the Special Camp (Survey)
