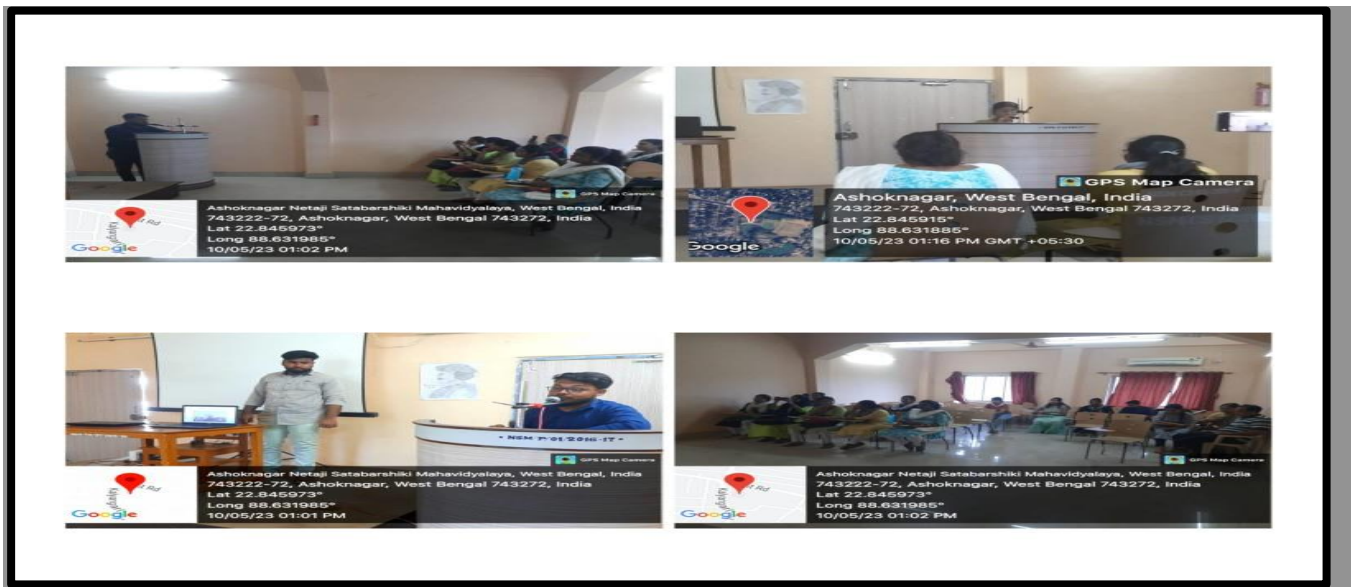


Report of Student Seminar on Raja Rammohan Roy

Organised by Department of Education in collaboration with IQAC

On 10th May, 2023, the Department of Education in collaboration with IQAC of Netaji Satabarshiki Mahavidyalaya organised a Student Seminar to commemorate the birth anniversary of Raja Rammohan Roy, the great educationist and social reformer of India. Students were asked to speak on one of the three topics: Rammohan as a social reformer, Rammohan as a reformer of education and Rammohan's notion of women. The current students and alumni from the department of education actively participated in the programme. Dr. Shree Chatterjee, the Head Department of Education hosted the programme. The programme started with lighting the lamp by the honourable Teacher in charge of the college, Sri Milinda Majumdar followed by his speech. Then Dr. Papri Chakrabarty, the IQAC coordinator of the college delivered a speech which was followed by a speech by Dr. Shree Chatterjee, the H.O.D. of the Department of Education. Ten minutes were given to each participant with a warning at eight minutes as exceeding the stipulated time would amount to negative marking. The faculty members imparted invaluable advice to the students as to how they can improve their speech in terms of quality and also how to think and express themselves. The students securing top three positions were awarded and all the participants were given certificates. The entire programme ended with great zeal.
